THE SUCCESSFUL APPLICANT

- must be a Gate City high school graduate who plans to attend an institution of higher learning for the pursuit of a degree or a course of study resulting in certification from a 4 year college, community college or technical school.

- must be a student of excellent moral character

- must include two typed paragraphs on a separate sheet answering the question: "What do you expect to gain from obtaining further education or training?"

- must submit two written references from:

1. a school official
2. a community leader of minister

- must submit an application form with all attachments to Gate City High School Guidance Office by April 15 in order to be considered.

- the scholarship must be used for education related expenses.

If the recipient finds that he/she will be unable to continue the education or training, the Scott County Ministerial Association should be notified as soon as possible.
